Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- A proof of service showing that a copy has been served on the agency and/or the Administrative Law Court has not been provided as required by Rule 203(b), SCACR.
- According to Rule 203(e) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, the notice of appeal shall contain the following information:
 - (A) The name of the court, judge, and county from which the appeal is taken.
 - (B) The docket number of the case in the lower court.
 - (C) The date of the order from which the appeal is taken; a statement of when the appealing party received notice of the order from which the appeal is taken.

(C) The date of the order from which the appeal is taken; a statement of when the appealing party received notice of the order from which the appeal is taken.

(D) The name of the party taking the appeal.

(E) The names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each.

- Please provide an amended notice of appeal containing only the above information and proof you have served the amended notice of appeal on all parties to the appeal.
