Dear Mr. Shearouse:

My firm represents the Appellant Stephens in this appeal. Respondent CSXT is represented by Ron Wray and others. SCDOT is represented by Andrew Lindemann and Peden McLeod.

The Court granted our Petition for Certiorari on September 11, 2014. Our Brief and copies of the Appendix are due for service today and the Appellant's Briefs have been served. However, due to the volume of the Appendix, thirteen copies of which are due to the Court and four copies more to the attorneys in the matter, I have been unable to complete getting these printed, bound, etc. by the deadline.

Being mindful of the Court's most recent Order concerning extensions and being admonished not to request the same, I am nevertheless forced to respectfully request a five (5) day extension within which to serve the copies of the Appendix upon the Court and all counsel. The Appendix itself is comprised of thousands of pages of pages per appendix, each copy being the rough equivalent of a banker's box.

I frankly did not realize the undertaking that printing and binding all of these copies was, or I would have had my staff start much earlier. Furthermore, due to the volume, should the Court be inclined to grant my request, I will have all of these hand delivered to the Court upon the due date, as mailing the copies of the Appendix, frankly, will be quite impractical.

I have communicated with SCDOT's counsel Mr. Lindemann and he consents to an extension for me to serve the Appendix. I have left Mr. Wray, counsel for CSXT, a message and due to his schedule, I have not heard back from him.

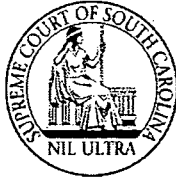
