MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Demetriss Glenn respectfully requests a **final seven (7) day extension, until October 29, 2014**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. **Counsel regrets the necessity of this extension request and will make every attempt to file the brief before the requested deadline but the facts that follow make this extension request absolutely necessary. The Office of Appellate Defense is also striving not to request any extension beyond a fourth and final if necessary. As Chief Appellate Defender undersigned counsel has many other responsibilities that unfortunately make this request necessary.** This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today.

2. Counsel for Demetriss Glenn respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. The good cause is counsel is working on and will be filing the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of Timothy D. Dingle v. State (murder case) with this Court today, October 22, 2014. Counsel is working on and planning to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Bradley Gerald Mullins with this Court on October 27, 2014. Counsel is working on and will be filing the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Victor White with the Supreme Court on October 29, 2014. Counsel is working on and will be filing the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Tawanda Allen with the Supreme Court on October 29, 2014. Counsel is also working on the death penalty case of The State v. Ricky Lee Blackwell. Counsel also is doing a presentation that he continues to prepare for after doing the materials on the Fourth Amendment for the Summary Judge's Conference on November 7, 2014.

4. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v Jason A. Bauman with this Court on October 16, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Christopher Heller before the Supreme Court on October 7, 2014. Counsel filed the final brief of petitioner in the case of Michael D. Hall v. State of South Carolina with co-counsel, Susan B. Hackett and David Alexander, with the Supreme Court on October 6, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Antonio Miller before this Court on October 6,

2014. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Michael Anthony Rogers in this Court on October 2, 2014. Counsel also went to death row at Lieber Correctional Institution on October 1, 2014 to meet with John Edward Weik. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing with co-counsel, Susan Hackett, in the case of Richard Bernard Moore v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on September 26, 2014. Counsel prepared for and presented his Case Law Update power-point presentation for the 2014 Annual Public Defender Conference held September 22-24, 2014 in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State of South Carolina v. Christina Reece with this Court on September 12, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Bobbie McCann before this Court on September 12, 2014. Counsel also had an oral argument in the case of State v. Jason Bauman before this Court on September 10, 2014. Counsel also had an oral argument in the case of State v. Derell Green, which he assisted Appellate Defender Lara Caudy in preparing to argue for him before this Court on September 8, 2014. Counsel also filed the reply to return to petition for writ of certiorari with co-counsel, Reid T. Sherard in the case of State v. Jamaal Hinson with the Supreme Court on September 8, 2014. Counsel also filed the brief of petitioner with co-counsel, David Alexander, in the case of State v. Darren Gerome Scott with the Supreme Court on September 4, 2014. Counsel also filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Anthony K. Blakney with this Court on September 4, 2014. Counsel also filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Andrew Antonio Clemons with this Court on September 4, 2014. **Counsel also has extensive administrative duties as the Chief Appellate Defender.**


5. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload


