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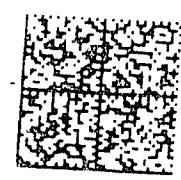
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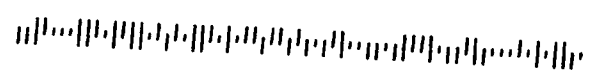



IT IS SO ORDERED, that the Complaint against the Defendant in the above-entitled action be dismissed with prejudice and forever ended.






Dear Curtis:
