## ORDER

Respondent filed a motion to dismiss Appellant's appeal or, alternatively, to strike numerous items from Appellant's Initial Brief and Designation of Matter. After careful consideration, this Court denies Respondent's motion to dismiss the appeal and grants Respondent's motion to strike the items listed as 1 through 19 in Respondent's motion because these items were not presented to the special referee. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR. This Court denies Respondent's motion to strike item 20, because this item was included in Appellant's Amended Designation of Matter, and item 21, because this item was presented to the special referee.

Appellant filed a motion to strike certain arguments set forth in Respondent's brief as additional sustaining grounds. After careful consideration, this Court denies the motion. *See* Rule 220(c), SCACR (stating the appellate court may affirm based on any ground appearing in the record).
