
1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed today.



Christopher Paul Mahaffey in this Court on September 9, 2014. Counsel filed the brief of petitioner in the case of State v. Darren G. Scott with the Supreme Court on September 4, 2014. 
