

Personally appear before me, a magistrate of this county one, Detective L. Glover, who first being duly sworn deposed and says that, Christopher D. Campbell, did within this county and state on the 4th of May, 2011 violate the criminal laws of the State of South Carolina in the following particular:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE

Possession of a Firearm During Commission of a Violent Crime
16-23-490

The affiant states there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named did commit the crime set forth and that such probable cause is based on the following facts:

That on 05/04/2011 at approximately 0830 hours at 357 King Street, which is located in the City and County of Charleston, South Carolina, the defendant, Christopher D. Campbell, did knowingly, willingly and unlawfully violate SC Statute 16-23-490 Possession of a Firearm During Commission of a Violent Crime.

That while at the above stated location, which is a Firehouse Subs business, the above named defendant did enter the business behind Leslie Green, an employee of the business. The defendant did present a black in color handgun and pointed it at another employee, Christopher Riley. The defendant demanded that Riley go to the back of the store in the safe and demanded, at gunpoint, for the money to be placed into the backpack he was carrying. Riley stated that he was in fear for his life and safety as the defendant pointed the gun directly at his head. The defendant then left the business with the money for his own personal gain. The defendant was identified as the individual who entered the business with the gun by Leslie Green. Green stated he knows Campbell by name and face and has lived with him in the past. Green also stated he was with Campbell directly before the robbery in the same vehicle together.

That the above is true and believable based upon the statements of Christopher Riley, Leslie Green and the investigations of Detective R Kennedy and the Charleston City Police Department.




