Dear Mr. Shearouse:

I represent South Carolina Electric & Gas Company ("SCE&G"), and I have been made aware that Mr. Joseph Wojcicki has filed with your office a document styled "Notice of Appeal" and other papers.

Identified in Mr. Wojcicki's Notice of Appeal are two orders entered by the Public Service Commission of South Carolina ("Commission"). These are Order No. 2014-764 and Order No. 2014-785. As noted in the text of Order No. 2014-764, Mr. Wojcicki's petition to intervene in Docket No. 2014-187-E was denied by Order No. 2014-733.

After Mr. Wojcicki's attempt to intervene was denied, the Commission issued Order No. 2014-785, deciding the merits of the case. Since Mr. Wojcicki was not a party to the Commission proceedings, he has no standing to appeal Order No. 2014-785 under Rule 201(b), SCACR.

Insofar as Mr. Wojcicki's Notice of Appeal refers to Order No. 2014-764, Mr. Wojcicki recites in his Notice of Appeal that he received the order on September 24, 2014. This is the order denying his petition for reconsideration. No proof of timely service of the Notice of Appeal has been filed with your office. It appears that Mr. Wojcicki transmitted a copy of his Notice of Appeal by e-mail to SCE&G, the South Carolina Office of Regulatory Staff, and the Commission within the period allowed for service, but transmission by this means is not service under Rule 233(b), SCACR.

SCE&G considered moving to dismiss Mr. Wojcicki's attempted appeal, but there is no appeal to dismiss. Since Mr. Wojcicki has now filed documents styled as an initial brief and a designation of matter, we felt it necessary to bring to your attention the fact that Mr. Wojcicki's attempt to appeal was unsuccessful.
