The undersigned counsel respectfully requests a **final fifteen day extension, until November 21, 2014**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the above-referenced case. 

State with this Court on October 8, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Marcus Allison in the Court of Appeals on October 6, 2014.

3. As indicated by his consent below, counsel for the state does not oppose this request.




