
2. The undersigned counsel of record requires additional time to compete Appellant's Brief and Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record. The basis for this



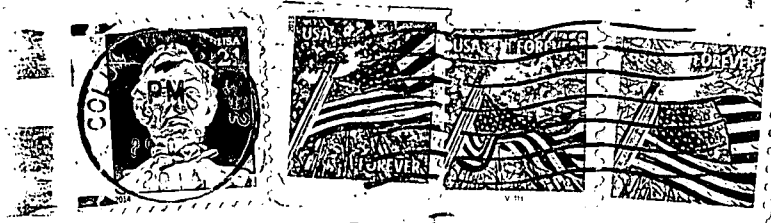
