
Dear Madam Kitchings:



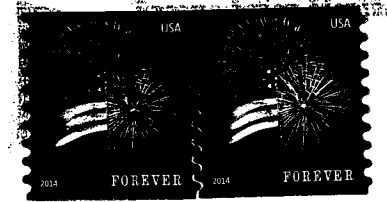
