Dear Ms. Kitchings:

First, I would like to apologize to you Ms. Kitchings, on behalf of my attorney Ms. Caroline and myself, for my explanation being served to you passed the 10 days that you sent your letter to my attorney. My attorney did not send the responded letter to me until the 10th of Oct, plus she didn't put the right address on the envelope and the letter was received at Perry Correctional Institute on the 15th of Oct and then sent and received here at Kirkland Evaluation Center mailroom on 17th of Oct and then I received the letter on the 20th of Oct in my dorm here waiting to be classified and sent to a prison where I want to add that I can't write with pen or do I have any excess to law material to write this in the right way to you, but I do have legal mail documentation showing the dates and times of travel for these letters being late. My explanation is about the decision Judge Miller made do to the victim in my case. My concern is that the victim is a Lt. and head of internal affairs division for greenville County police department. And I believe he used his position as a high authority to his advantage to influence Judge millers decision in this sentencing. Judge Miller who is a greenville based Judge who has worked with Lt. Brad steps before, because if you get the recordings of the first court hearing and read/listen to it, you will hear Lt. Brad steps saying and I quote "I am embarrassed of this situation that I am in because I am in the presents of my co workers."

Meaning cops, clerks, law s, solicitors and Judges. that first hearing Judge miller had me ordered to see his recommended psychiatrist, Dr. Price to get evaluated by, which Dr price found a low tolerance of anything happening again to this Lt. Brad steps by me. So when I came back to court on Sept 11, 2014, I had 18 and half months of time done, with the first plea offer from the assistant Solicitor for mental health counseling, drug program and no contact with victim, with Dr. Prices evaluation (which was in my favor)! Now when you read/listen the recordings of 2nd and last court date of sept 11, 2014 you will hear my lawyer Caroline Horlbeck reading off Dr. price evaluation to Judge miller, then says with his hands out wide and looking at the victim, solicitor, and me "I don't know what to do, I always go with Dr price decision in all my cases, plus Brandon is being sincere, I need more time to think this over." Now in this time I don't know what happen because when we came back in front of Judge miller he sentence me to 10yrs suspended to 3yrs, 1yr in overcomes program and 5 yrs probation with a Ops foot monitor on the whole time on probation, I believe and many people in that court room have told me and my mom that they did not see that outcome coming from Judge miller and that they could tell that the cops had used there power to influence the Judges decision that day. Now when court WAS done and I went back to the holding cell and my mom WALK out of the courtroom and into the hall way, Lt. Bradd steps came at her and said to tell Brandon that if I was to try anything else that he would make sure that I got 18 years in prison! I would like to tell you that he has misused his power since day one of my arrest of March 3, 2013, he is dating the mother of my child, which I have the CDV with in this case. And I have found out threw her, the mother of my child, that she has told my mother our babysitter that he has used his authority to punish me beyond what was called for! which this is coming from the other victim in my case, now she also sees how he has lied to her and pushed his power on the courts. Why would I go in front of a Greenville County court Judge with the victim being a Greenville County police officer, and to my opinion, knows Judge miller very well! I CAN'T see even after my guilty plea that I submitted, that there was a fair balance of justice done that day!
