ORDER

Appellate Defender Robert M. Pachak has filed a brief pursuant to *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738 (1967), and a motion to be relieved as counsel. Subsequently, Sonya Chachere-Compton and Valerie V. Vie filed a motion to be substituted as counsel of record for Appellant and a motion to amend Appellant's final brief.
