The undersigned counsel respectfully requests a **final thirty day extension, until December 8, 2014** in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the above-referenced case. In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following extraordinary circumstances:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case are due to be served and filed today.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Thomas Porter v. State with this Court on October 20, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. James Scofield in the Court of Appeals on October 15, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Sammy Scott v. State with the Supreme Court on October 7, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Dominique Shumate in the Court of Appeals on October 7, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Latrone Butler with the Court of Appeals on October 2, 2014.

3. As indicated by his consent below, counsel for the state does not oppose this request.




