
Dear Counsel:

The Court is in receipt of your correspondence dated November 3, 2014 and is construing it as a notice of appeal. Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the title of the case is not listed, the general sessions number is not listed, and opposing counsel is not listed.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by a redacted copy of the order(s) and/or sentencing sheet(s) challenged on appeal.
- A proof of service has not been provided showing service on opposing counsel. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The document is not legible. The document will need to be resubmitted in a format that is legible and complies with the requirements of Rule 267, SCACR.

- The document has not been timely filed. A motion to allow the late filing will have to be made.
