

ORDER

Petitioner's motion to proceed in forma pauperis is granted. Petitioner's motions to be furnished a transcript without cost and be appointed counsel are denied. *See Lakes v. State*, 333 S.C. 382, 385, 510 S.E.2d 228, 230 (Ct. App. 1998) ("A litigant proceeding *in forma pauperis* is only entitled to filing fees, not court reporter's costs or copying costs."); *Anders v. State*, 305 S.C. 453, 454, 409 S.E.2d 395, 396 (1991) (noting "the constitutional right to counsel does not extend to discretionary appeals on collateral attack").
