

**MOTION TO PERMIT THE DELIVERY

Petitioner moves this Court to permit delivery of a recorded statement for inclusion in the appendix. With this motion, Petitioner submits the recorded statement for inclusion in the appendix.


On February 19, 2014, the Honorable G. Edward Welmaker presided over an evidentiary hearing concerning Petitioner's PCR application. During the hearing, Petitioner raised an issue regarding a statement he purportedly gave to law enforcement that was recorded. Judge Welmaker agreed to leave the record open for Petitioner to submit the recorded statement. On February 28, 2014, Petitioner provided the judge with the recording. See Exhibit A (letter dated February 28, 2014). According to the Court's order, the

recording was submitted for review, and the Court reviewed it in rendering its opinion. App. 97. However, the recording was not made an exhibit; therefore, it is not in the possession of the Clerk of Court. Undersigned counsel obtained a copy of the recording, and has provided a copy of the recording to Respondent.


Petitioner and Respondent agree that the recording is part of the lower court record. To comply with Rule 243(f), it is necessary for Petitioner to provide this Court with a copy of the recording to ensure the appendix is a complete copy of the "entire lower court record." Undersigned counsel is in possession of the recording. Accordingly, Petitioner respectfully asks this Court to permit Petitioner to deliver the recording to this Court for inclusion in the appendix and for this Court to accept the filing of the recording for consideration of this appeal.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests this Court allow Petitioner to deliver the recorded statement to this Court and accept the filing for consideration on the appeal.






