

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Thomas Porter v. State with the Supreme Court on October 20, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. James Scofield in this Court on October 15, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Sammy Scott v. State with the Supreme Court on October 7, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Dominique Shumate in this Court on October 7, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Latrone Butler with this Court on October 2, 2014.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


4. As indicated by his consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.


