MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Larry Hendricks respectfully requests a **final extension of thirty (30) days, until December 12, 2014**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Larry Hendricks respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.
3. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Xavier Perry v. State with the Supreme Court on November 10, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Maurio Rivers in this Court on November 5, 2014. Counsel

filed the petition for rehearing in the case of the State v. James Harris with this Court on October 30, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of Randy Crosby v. State with the Supreme Court on October 27, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Hazell Stoudemire v. State with the Supreme Court on October 20, 2014. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Ian Rice v. State with the Supreme Court on October 15, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Elizabeth Dinkins with this Court on October 9, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of Rodney Young v. State with the Supreme Court on October 8, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of Darnell Russell v. State with the Supreme Court on October 8, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Marcus Allison in this Court on October 6, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief and designation of matter in the case of State v. Toshonda Mickens with this Court on October 2, 2014.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.






