ORDER

The South Carolina Court of Appeals dismissed the appeal in this matter based on petitioner's failure to pay the filing fee required by Rule 203 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. The Court of Appeals denied rehearing by order dated September 30, 2014.¹
