Dear Counsel:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by the order(s) and/or judgment(s) challenged on appeal.
- The required filing fee has not been submitted. The correct filing fee is \$100.
- A proof of service has not been provided. You must serve and file a proof of service substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- A proof of service showing that a copy has been timely served on the agency and/or the Administrative Law Court has not been provided as required by Rule 203(b), SCACR.
- In appeals from administrative tribunals, the notice of appeal shall contain the following information:
 - (A) The name of the agency and the name of the administrative law judge (if applicable).
 - (B) The docket number of the case before the administrative law court, or if the appeal is from an agency, the docket number before the agency.

(C) The date of the decision from which the appeal is taken; a statement of when the appealing party received the decision from which the appeal is taken.

(D) The name of the party taking the appeal.

(E) The names, mailing addresses, and telephone numbers of all attorneys of record and the names of the party or parties represented by each.

Please provide an amended notice of appeal removing all unnecessary information.
