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NOW COMES, the aboved named appellant, "Pro Se" moving before this court to MOTION TO CHALLENGE TRANSCRIPT. CONTENT, Pursuant to South Carolina Rules of Court, Rule 607, all before the respected time limit, to ensure procedural due process and a fair opportunity for judicial review of this court.

The appellant is currently appealing an ORDER OF DISMISSAL entered by the Honorable Judges James Barber, that presided over the post-conviction relief hearings. Two (2) hearings were convened one on October 2, 2013 and the other January 22, 2014, in the County of Richland.

The hearing of October 2, 2013, and transcript was transcribed by Court Reporter Elizabeth Harris. The hearing of January 22, 2014, and transcript was transcribed by Court Reporter Bonnie Kelly. Request for transcripts were made April 26, 2014 to Bonnie Kelly, and August 11, 2014 to Elizabeth Harris. Wherefore, they were both transcribed and delivered October 17, 2014.

Specific testimonies in the transcripts are omitted and altered, which are vital testimonies given by involved parties, which the South Carolina Supreme Court must weigh heavily on the credibility of the testimonies entered into the record, when reviewing in determining whether relief should be granted

These transcripts should include the bias and prejudicial comments made by the Honorable Judge James Barber, where such comments and actions impair the fairness of post-conviction proceedings and denied the appellant due process in hindering the opportunity to introduce evidence of probative value, and denied the appellant a "Full and Fair Bite at the Apple."

Prior to submitting this motion the appellant acted diligently in notifying and informing the court, court reporters and counsel that the transcript content be accurate and precise to that of the actual hearing. Even entering a NOTICE OF JUDICIAL MISCONDUCT on April 3, 2014 that identified grounds for prejudicial vindictiveness. These notification are clock stamped with the clerk of court, into this inquiry.

WHEREFORE, the appellant being notified responsible parties and they have failed to reasonably respond in a respectful timely manner to challenge the transcript content, the appellant prays to have the transcripts altered and amended to be accurate and precise to that of the actual proceedings. All to ensure procedural due process under the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendments of the United States Constitution, but moreso to allow the appellant the opportunity to be heard in a meaningful manner to receive a Full and Fair Bite at the Apple.


