## ORDER

Respondent moves to dismiss the appeal, alleging no personal representative has been appointed to the estate of the deceased appellant. Appellant has provided proof of the appointment of a personal representative to decedent's estate, and now moves to substitute the personal representative as the named party to this action. Respondent has no objection to appellant's motion to substitute the named party. Accordingly, appellant's motion to substitute the named party is granted pursuant to Rule 265(b), SCACR, and respondent's motion to dismiss the appeal is denied.
