anyone win. Thank you

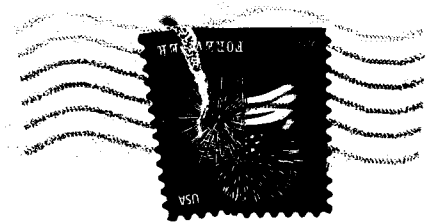
