PETITION FOR EXTENSION TO FILE

The undersigned counsel respectfully requests a **final thirty day extension, until December 29, 2014**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the above-referenced case. In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following extraordinary circumstances:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case are due to be served and filed today.
2. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Adrian White v. State with the Supreme Court on November 21, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Marcus Greene v. State

James Harris with the Court of Appeals on October 30, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of Randy Crosby v. State with the Supreme Court on October 27, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Hazell Stoudemire v. State with the Supreme Court on October 20, 2014. Counsel filed the return to petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Ian Rice v. State with the Supreme Court on October 15, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of State v. Elizabeth Dinkins with the Court of Appeals on October 9, 2014.

3. As indicated by his consent below, counsel for the state does not oppose this request.




