Pursuant to Rule 240, SCACR, respondents Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (“DEC”) and the North Carolina Electric Membership Corporation (“NCEMC”) move for an extension of time in which to serve and file respondents’ Initial Brief and Designation of Matter to be included in the Record on Appeal (“Designation of Matter”). DEC and NCEMC request an extension of thirty days to file the Initial Brief and Designation of Matter which are currently due on December 12, 2014. 


