
INDICTMENT

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on May 9, 2011 the Grand Jurors of Charleston County present upon their oath:

Forgery

That in Charleston County, South Carolina, on or about December 21, 2010, the Defendant, BRUCE KENNY HESTER, with intent to defraud, falsely did make, forge, counterfeit or did cause or procure falsely to be made, forged, or counterfeited a writing, or did utter and publish as true a forged, false or counterfeited writing, or willfully act or assist in any of the foregoing, to wit: the defendant did present check number 54 to Ameris Bank drawn located at 834 Savannah Hwy, Charleston, SC, on the account number 81 of Urban Electric Company, the check in the amount of Nine Hundred Fifty Nine Dollars and Fifteen Cents, all in violation of Section 16-13-10, Code of Laws of South Carolina, (1976, as amended).

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.
