The undersigned counsel respectfully requests a **final thirty day extension, until December 29, 2014** in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the above-referenced case. In support of this motion, counsel would respectfully show the Court the following extraordinary circumstances:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in this case are due to be served and filed today.

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Eric Todd Burgess v. State with this Court on October 22, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Rufus Raiden with the Court of Appeals on October 20, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Thomas Porter v. State with this Court on October 20, 2014.


3. As indicated by his consent below, counsel for the state does not oppose this request.




