Special Conditions-The offender was ordered by the Court to complete 30 days weekend time. The offender reported for his first weekend around 9-27-14. The offender was supposed to report the following weekend but after a news story aired claiming the offender was a suspect in a kidnapping/robbery, he failed to report for his weekend time.

Agent's Recommendation:

Full revocation and convert restitution to civil judgement.

Agent's Justification:

During the offender's last violation hearing he was before the Honorable Roger Couch, in which the judge advised him not to come before the court again for another violation. The offender was also ordered to perform 30 days weekend time. The offender reported for the start of his weekend time on 9-27-14. Between his first and second weekend date which was to begin 10-4-14, the offender was accused of a kidnapping/robbery that occurred close to campus of USC Upstate. Agent spoke with the person over the weekend program at jail, and she advised that the offender called her and stated he could not report weekend of October 4th. Per the doctor's excuse he provided he was seen on October 6th and excused for Oct 6, 7, 8, 9, 10 and could return on October 13th, 2014. The offender also failed to report for his public service employment which began 10-16-14 at 9 am at New Life Christian Fellowship.
