MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel is also working on and will be filing the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of The State v. Jefferson Perry with the Supreme Court on December 4, 2014. **Counsel also has extensive administrative duties as the Chief Appellate Defender.**






