

AFFIDAVIT

Personally appeared before me name of attorney, who, under oath, deposes and says the following:

I am name of attorney and I am Chief Public Defender for Colleton County, South Carolina, a division of the Fourteenth Judicial Circuit Public Defender's Office. In that capacity I was assigned the defense of the appellant, Raymond Powell, charged with Two Counts of Attempted Murder, and Two Counts of Possession of a Weapon During the Commission of a Violent Crime. I prepared the case for trial and it was called on date of trial. Immediately prior to trial, the Defendant accepted a plea offer of a cap of 20 years, concurrent (and the dismissal of one of the Possession of a Weapon During the Commission of a Violent Crime), and was sentenced by the Honorable Perry M. Buckner to 19 years on each of the Attempted Murders, and 5 years on the Possession of a Weapon During the Commission of a Violent Crime, all concurrent.

Thereafter and during the same week of court I was instructed by my client to file an appeal of his conviction and sentence. I have filed the appeal and submitted it to the Court of

Appeals with copies to the office of Appellant Defense who will actually handle the appeal as it progresses. I am unaware of any appealable issues, but have filed an appeal pursuant to the Request of my client.

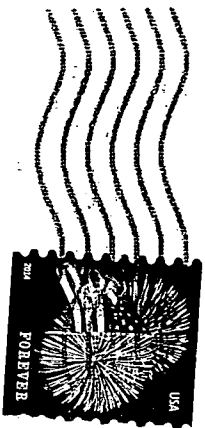
