

ORDER

Respondent has filed an objection to Appellant's motion to file his initial brief and designation of matter out of time, arguing there is a transcript of the proceeding before Judge Dukes and Appellant has misled the court and is refusing to order the transcript.

Appellant shall provide proof that he has ordered the transcript within ten days or this appeal may be dismissed. See Rule 207, SCACR (requiring the appellant to order the transcript of the entire proceedings below unless the parties otherwise agree in writing).

We strike Appellant's initial brief and designation as prematurely filed. Appellant shall serve and file an amended initial brief and designation of matter within thirty days of receipt of the transcript.
