

## ORDER

In this court's November 18, 2014 order, we interpreted Appellant's motion to be a motion to relieve counsel, and then granted that motion. Appellant has now filed a motion contending that her prior motion was a motion to appoint counsel. We stand by our previous interpretation and ruling. In addition, however, we now deny Appellant's motion to the extent it was a motion to appoint counsel.
