This letter is in reference to me not receiving the transcript of my (PCR) hearing that was held since May, 27, 2014. Now, I was told by someone from the South Carolina Indigent Defense, that my transcript was ordered on Oct 7, 2014. 60 days from that date will of course be Dec 7, 2014 which is (4) days from today. In appeals from the court of common pleas, matters in equity, special referees or the family court in domestic actions, the transcript must be ordered within (10) days after the date of service of the notice of appeal. Now the appeal was filed in your court on Sept 18, 2014 so the transcript should have been ordered no later than Sept 28, 2014; and received no later than Nov, 28, 2014. - Rule 207-Transcript

of Proceedings. If appellants have not received the transcript within the allotted time — nor received notification of an extension within (10) days of the allotted time, appellants shall notify the Office of Administration, the clerk of appellate court, and the court reporter in writing.

\* Failure to Comply: The willful failure of a court reporter to comply with the provision of this rule shall constitute contempt of court enforceable by Order of Supreme Court. This is my writing, you notifying you of what is going on so you can Please Sir, rectify this.

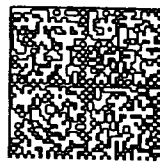

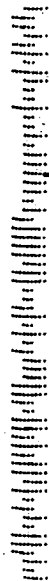
