My name is Enoch Walters I filed a notice of appeal with the South Carolina Court of Appeals (2014-002274) in regards to case #13136GR. I received a response from the South Carolina Court of Appeals stating this appeal was dismissed without prejudice due to the appeal should have been filed with the Lexington County Court of Common Pleas pursuant to Rule 18 of the South Carolina Rules of Magistrate Court of Common Pleas. I ask this court to please reconsider and overturn this decision based on the facts listed below.

I contacted the Lexington County Court of Common Pleas after the decision was reached and they instructed me to file with the South Carolina Court of Appeals due to the fact that they would not hear the case. I stated that under Rule 18 of the South Carolina Rules of Magistrate Court of Common Pleas they must accept my appeal. Again, I was instructed to file my appeal with the South Carolina Court of Appeals. I have challenged the jurisdiction of the county courts, magistrates' office and judges in this case during the pretrial hearing and during trial. A "Writ of Quo Warranto" was filed and sent to all parties listed. A response was never issued. This is in violation of Title 15 (15-63-60) of the South Carolina Code of Laws. Looking at all judges' oath's and bonds ruling over this matter, neither judge had the right to hear this or any case due to the oath was taken before their bond was issued. Again, this is in violation of South Carolina Code of Laws 22-1-150.

I believe I was purposefully given misleading information from the Lexington County Court of Common Pleas to prevent me from filing my appeal due to the concerns listed and others you will find within my appeal to your office. I am only asking that my appeal be granted either through your court or in the appropriate court as listed in Rule 18 of the South Carolina Rules of Magistrate Court of Common Pleas.
