
Dear Brook:

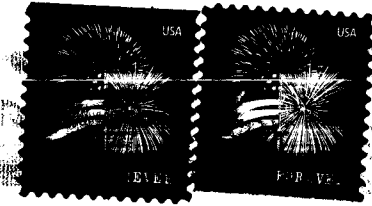
