On September 27, 2014, the transcripts of the proceedings in this case was ordered. Dear Mr. Wilson,

This is to acknowledge that on October 1, 2014 I received your transcript requests in the above-referenced case. I have reviewed my records and estimate that the September 6, 2013 transcript will be approximately 47 pages long for a cost of \$152.75, and the March 12, 2014 transcript will be approximately 12 pages long for a cost of \$39. The total estimated charge for both transcripts will be \$196.80, which includes shipping costs.

Rule 607 provides that the rate of \$3.25 shall be charged per page for an original certified transcript of record. Anything requested expedited is charged pursuant to State guidelines, and I can furnish that information if you require an expedited transcript. Upon receipt of your deposit funds I will place your request in line for production. If the final invoice is less than the quoted price, I will refund the difference to you upon delivery of the transcript; likewise, if it is more, the balance will be due prior to delivery of the transcript.

Under our Rules I have 60 days in which to complete the transcript after the receipt of your deposit. In addition, I am allowed to request from Court Administration 30-day extensions, if necessary, to complete the transcript. You will be notified if extensions are granted. If you desire to cancel your request for the transcript, a cancellation request must be made in writing. You will be responsible for payment of any portion of the transcript that has been completed.

If you want me to proceed with the production of your transcript, please send a postal money order or bank cashier's check in the amount of \$196.80 made payable to me at the above address, and I will be happy to proceed.
