Dear Counsel:

The Court has received what is being construed as your initial brief of appellant and designation of matter on December 10, 2014.

Upon reviewing your initial brief of appellant and designation of matter, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter:

- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the title of the document should be Initial Brief of Appellant and all attorneys for the appellant need to be listed, including local counsel.
- The designation of matter needs to list specifically what documents and exhibits, including exhibit numbers and descriptions, are to be included in

the Record on Appeal. Please see Rule 209, SCACR. The documents and exhibits listed in the designation of matter of the appellant and respondent are then to be included in the Record on Appeal, not with the initial brief nor the final brief.

- When filing the initial brief of appellant, only one unbound original initial brief is required. When it comes time to file the final brief, please note that one unbound copy and fourteen bound copies with blue covers, not a plastic cover, is required.
- The initial brief of appellant must be signed by local counsel. Rule 404(i), SCACR (as amended May 14, 2014).
