MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for James Scott Cross respectfully requests a final **thirty-day (30) extension, until January 5, 2015**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. **Counsel regrets the necessity of this extension request and will make every attempt to file the brief before the requested deadline but the facts that follow make this extension request absolutely necessary.** This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for James Scott Cross respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel is working on and will be filing the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Laborse Macon with this Court today, December 5, 2014. Counsel also has an oral argument in the case of Michael A. Hough v. The State which he is assisting Appellate Defender Lara Caudy in preparing to argue for him before this Court on December 8, 2014. Counsel also has an oral argument in the case of Michael D. Hall v. State of South Carolina, et al. before the Supreme Court on December 9, 2014. Counsel also has an oral argument in the case of The State v. Derrick McDonald before the Supreme Court on December 11, 2014. Counsel is working on and will be filing the brief of petitioner in the case of The State v. South Carolina v. Manuel Marin with the Supreme Court on December 11, 2014.

4. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of The State v. Michael Rogers with the Supreme Court on December 4, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of The State v. Jefferson Perry with the Supreme Court on December 4, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of The State v. Anthony K. Blakney with the Supreme Court on December 4, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Ryan P. Deleston with this Court on December 3, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for rehearing in the case of The State v. Antonio Miller with this Court on December 1, 2014. Counsel filed the United States certiorari petition in the case of Bayan Aleksey v. State of South Carolina on November 24, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Richard Keith Poe v. State of South Carolina with the Supreme Court on November 21, 2014. Counsel attended a PCR Hearing on November 18, 2014 in Richland County in the case of Quincy Jovan Allen v. The State. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari in the case of Sammie Louis Stokes v. State of South Carolina (death penalty


case) with the Supreme Court on November 12, 2014. Counsel gave a presentation that he continued to prepare for after doing the materials on the Fourth Amendment for the Summary Judge's Conference on November 7, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Bradley Gerald Mullins with this Court on November 4, 2014. Counsel filed a petition for stay of execution in the case of The State v. Richard Moore with the Supreme Court on October 31, 2014. Counsel presented the Appellate Project CLE on October 30, 2014. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Victor White with the Supreme Court on October 30, 2014. Counsel attended a PCR hearing on October 29, 2014 in Dorchester County in the case of Walter Lee Harris v. State of South Carolina. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Tawanda Allen with the Supreme Court on October 27, 2014. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of Timothy D. Dingle v. The State (murder case) with this Court on October 22, 2014. Hackett and David Alexander, with the Supreme Court on October 6, 2014. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of The State v. Antonio Miller before this Court on October 6, 2014.

5. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


6. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.


