ORDER

Appellant Lake City College Preparatory Academy has appealed an order from the Administrative Law Court upholding the decision of the South Carolina Public Charter School District to revoke Lake City's charter. Lake City has also filed a "Motion to Expedite and to Reinstate Funds." We construe Lake City's request to reinstate funds as a request for a supersedeas as to the revocation of its charter. Respondent, South Carolina Public Charter School District, filed a return taking no position on the motion to expedite but opposing Lake City's request regarding the reinstatement of funds. Lake City did not file a reply.

After consideration of the parties' filings, we grant Lake City's request to expedite the case. No extensions will be granted absent extraordinary circumstances. Lake City shall notify this court when it has received a copy of the transcript so that this court can establish an expedited briefing schedule. We deny Lake City's request for a supersedeas. *See* Rule 241(c)(2), SCACR ("In determining whether an order should issue pursuant to this Rule, [this court] should consider whether such an order is necessary to preserve jurisdiction of the appeal or to prevent a contested issue from becoming moot.").
