ORDER

On May 16, 2014, this appeal was dismissed due to Appellant's failure to order the trial transcript and timely serve and file her initial brief and designation of matter as required by Rules 207, 208, and 209 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. On May 27, 2014, Appellant filed a motion to reinstate the appeal. This court granted the motion on June 27, 2014, and gave Appellant thirty days in which to file her initial brief and designation of matter. On July 14, 2014, Appellant filed a motion for extension of time to file her initial brief and designation of matter. This court granted the motion on August 6, 2014, and gave Appellant an additional twenty days to submit the filings. Appellant was advised that no more extensions would be given absent extraordinary circumstances. On September 9, 2014, this court requested an update from Appellant as to the status of her initial brief and designation of matter. Appellant failed to respond, and the case was again dismissed on October 14, 2014.

On October 21, 2014, Appellant filed a petition to rehear the order of dismissal and reinstate the appeal, as well as a "Motion for Full Panell [sic] Review" and a motion for an extension of time to file her initial brief and designation of matter. Despite Appellant's failure to present any extraordinary circumstances necessitating a second extension of time, this Court gave Appellant ten days to submit her filings before considering the petition and motions. However, Appellant has made no attempt to comply with the court's previous order. Moreover, after careful consideration of the petition for rehearing, the court is unable to discover that any material fact or principle of law has been either

overlooked or disregarded, and hence, there is no basis for granting a rehearing. Accordingly, Appellant's petition and motions are denied. The remittitur will be sent as provided by Rule 221(b) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
