## ORDER




The State moves to strike pages 1-13 of the supplemental appendix filed by petitioner in this matter, and the entire second supplemental appendix. The State also moves to strike the portions of petitioner's thirty-seven page petition for a writ of certiorari that exceed the twenty-five page limit set forth in Rule 243(e)(3), SCACR. Petitioner has filed a return in opposition to the motion to strike. He has also filed a motion to exceed the page limits set forth in Rule 243(e)(3) and a motion to supplement the appendix. The State has not filed a return to either motion.


We grant the motion to strike as to pages 1-8 of the supplemental appendix and as to the entire second supplemental appendix. We grant petitioner's motion to exceed the page limit and deny the State's motion to strike with regard to the petition for a writ of certiorari. Finally, we deny the motion to supplement the appendix.
