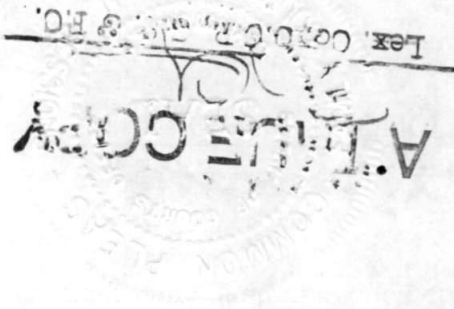

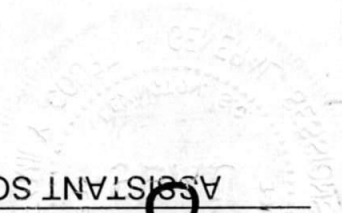
At a Court of General Sessions, convened on JUNE 2014, the Grand Jurors of Lexington County present upon their oath:




