EXTEND TIME AND MEMORANDUM**



5. With the holiday break approaching, and the time off from work which that entails, I will not be able to complete the Reply Brief until after Christmas.


6. The Appellants' Reply Brief would otherwise be due on December 19, 2014, and I am requesting a ten day extension through and including Monday, December 29, 2014.


