ORDER

Luke J. Malloy, an assistant public defender, has filed a motion requesting he be relieved as counsel of record for Appellant. Mr. Malloy states in his motion that Appellant's indigency status has been reviewed "pursuant to South Carolina Appellate Court Rule 602(c), and it was determined that he is in fact financially able to retain legal counsel."
