ORDER FOR MERGER


Applicant in the above-captioned matters has filed two separate applications for post-conviction relief. Each application challenges the same conviction and makes similar allegations in regards to the subject convictions (2010-CP-32-01899 & 2012-CP-32-02781). Since an applicant is not generally permitted to have multiple post-conviction relief proceedings in regards to the *same convictions* (See Aice v. State, 305 S.C. 448, 409 S.E.2d 392 (1991); Foxworth v. State, 275 S.C. 615, 274 S.E.2d 415 (1981); S.C. Code Ann. § 17-27-90), this Court hereby orders that the two proceedings be merged. The second application for post-conviction relief (2012-CP-32-02781) will be considered an *amendment* to the initial application for post-conviction relief (2010-CP-32-01899).

The Lexington County Clerk of Court is therefore ordered to merge the two cases, with docket number 2010-CP-32-01899 being the surviving case. Hereafter, the word "Application" will refer to docket number 2010-CP-32-01899 and the word "Amendment" will refer to docket number 2012-CP-32-02781, which will be considered an amendment to the application for post-conviction relief.
