Dear Mr. Prang:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiency or deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and any deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR, and all parties involved in the appeal must be served all documents filed.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the notice is not in the proper format. The lower court information is not complete, and the name of the trial court judge is not provided.
- The notice of appeal is not accompanied by a redacted copy of the order(s) and/or sentencing sheet(s) challenged on appeal.
- If you would like to have counsel appointed you must serve and file a proper motion to appoint counsel.
