The South Carolina Department of Revenue respectfully requests a fifteen (15) day extension of time to file a Petition for Rehearing in the above-referenced case. The Court's opinion was issued on December 23, 2014 so that the original period for filing for rehearing would expire on January 7, 2015. With extension, any filing would be due by January 22, 2015.

The Department believes that the Court's opinion called attention to an unresolved issue between the parties.
