I had suplement ite discovered missing and the deputy said she'd send a copy which I only recently received. and am enclosing for you.

Inotified the courtat the beginningI was affected by the two cerebral s strokeswhich prevent me from writing by had and critically affects my sh short trem memoryMy long term memory allows my thoughts to flow somewhat easily if I speak but it does not seem to allow me to write. If I am overwheled Ihave discovered inflamation occurs and I actually have a mom men tary literal brain freeze. I don't mean to soundso complaining I can am very fortunate I can speak and walk.

Last spring I was Particularly overwhelmed handling the vitally important/ appeal matters. So I Briefly and in a limited manner enlisted the help of one of my new neighbors, a retired registered nurse to assist meprima me primarily to copy, file collate and fill and mail envelopes. She was a tremendous help to me

I assigned her particularly April Heron's file, she's a courtreporter for Garrison HillThe only thing I especially recall about april/ Herron's file was a wet check *my neighbor mentioned*

I had to contactthe records department of the greenville county court house to work with the clerks to verify case numbers , reporter names and adresses and contact info for themultiple hearingin both courts

I recall great confusion from Hollie Jenkins' initial response to me.

Her caseStyle Name and number was not what I sent her,

I contactedthe records clerk to determined if I recorded something in correctly. and sent her thename and number of the mis information. she said somtimes there are fliing aerrors. I surely didnt want a hybrid transcript.

I tried to figure thiis out with Hollie Jenkins. But the matter got moreconfusing because Her letterhead was the same as the judg judge's. Then both caes were the same amount which seemd peculiar. I sen snt her \$50. to indicate my earnestess. Believing she couldget started and let mr know the corrcrct difference.. I bought a money order that Had the incórrrect change amount and was afraid that probably wouldn't due for her.

I had several calls with ms. Desiree Allen. Finally

Near the beginning of school My phone stopped working on my home line. I had to go to a neighbor hosue to call Ms Alen. The neighbheard me talking and she commented the nme Stinsonv. Hans and Frans wasa restaurant in greer and why was I suing them.

I asked Ms. Allen what to do and she said Mrs. Jenkins should get it right that she was a professional.



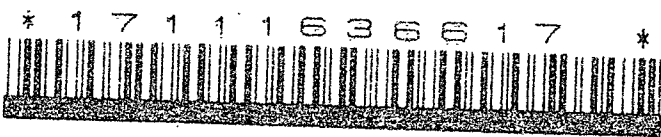

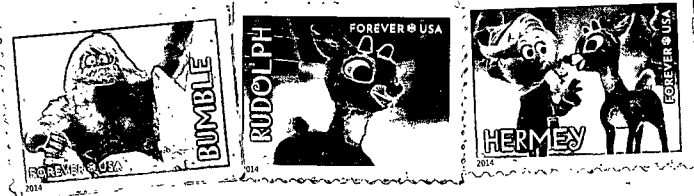
