MOTION TO TRANSPORT AND SEAL STATE'S EXHIBITS 1-4 AND 22-29


Counsel petitions this Court to transport and seal State's Exhibits 1-4 and 22-29 in the above captioned case. The undersigned respectfully shows the Court:

1. Appellant was convicted in the Greenwood County Court of General Sessions of inflicting great bodily injury upon a child. Appellant appealed his conviction to this Court.
2. At trial, the State introduced into evidence photographs of the minor child allegedly injured by appellant. Appellant designated certain of those photographs to be part of this Court's record on appeal. Those photographs are State's Exhibits 1-4 and 22-29.

3. Since these are photographs of a child, counsel for appellant asks this Court to issue an Order requiring these exhibits be transported from the trial court and placed under seal for review only by the Court and the attorneys for the parties. This motion is made to comply with this Court's rules on redaction of sensitive material and to protect the privacy of the child depicted in the photographs.
4. Counsel for Appellant has conferred with Assistant Attorney General J. Benjamin Aplin, attorney for Respondent the State of South Carolina, and he consents to this motion.

WHEREFORE, Counsel respectfully requests that this Court grant his motion and issue an Order requiring the transportation of Exhibits 1-4 and 22-29 and that they be sealed with review allowed only by the attorneys for the parties and the Court.






